CHOOSE FROM THE FOLLOWING SITES:

ALLEN ROAD PARK

Join us to improve a neighborhood park with creek clean-up and mulching trail areas with Trees Sandy Springs. Parents must accompany children.

BIG TREES FOREST PRESERVE

Maintain the trails at this beautiful and unique urban forest and wildlife sanctuary hidden on Roswell Road.

CHATTAHOOCHEE NATIONAL RECREATION AREA (ISLAND FORD)

Invasive species removal in this wilderness treasure where you can hike, fish, picnic or enjoy the rocky shoals.

COMMUNITY ACTION CENTER

Community Action Center is the only agency in Sandy Springs and Dunwoody to focus on preventing homelessness and providing basic needs to individuals and families. General clean up and organization projects will be done at this food bank, thrift shop and client training facility. Space is limited!

HAMMOND PARK

Work on landscaping, trail development, indoor painting and other site improvement projects at Hammond Park which houses a recreation/community center, gym, athletic fields, courts, picnic areas, and playgrounds. One handicapped accessible.

HERITAGE SANDY SPRINGS

Perform walking path maintenance, painting and light landscaping at Heritage Sandy Springs whose mission is to preserve and promote the historic and cultural identity of Sandy Springs. HSS presents multiple community programs and events and runs Heritage Green which includes the Sandy Springs Historic Site, Williams-Payne House Museum and the Sandy Springs Society Entertainment Lawn.

KEEP SANDY SPRINGS BEAUTIFUL RECYCLING CENTER

Working at the recycling and environmental education center assisting with recycling, general clean-up, and work in the compost areas

LINK COUNSELING CENTER

Spruce up both indoors and outdoors at this center which provides quality, confidential counseling, psychotherapy and support groups for all ages on a low cost sliding scale.

RIDGEVIEW PARK

Volunteers will work on the Fitness Trail, play area, and picnic grounds and do general site beautification.
